

CONCHO ANNUAL MEMORIAL DAY PARADE

May 25, 2009 at 10AM



Concho CAN! is sponsoring the Fourth Annual Concho Memorial Day Parade. You are invited to join with us to honor and commemorate all who have served in the military and defense of our country. There are no entry fees and refreshments will be served to all participants at its conclusion.

Staging: 8 to 9:00AM, Concho Elementary School parking lot with judging beginning at 9:00AM.

Awards: most original group or individual, best vintage vehicle, best band, best float, best farm tractor, best equestrian unit or individual, best bicycle, most recent military service, oldest military veteran, best of parade theme, and honorable mention.

Route: north on State Route 61, west on Commercial Drive, ending at Lions Park. A ceremony and flag raising will be held at the northeast corner of the park.

Guidelines: It is the desire of the Parade Committee that all entries best reflect the traditions, culture, talents, and integrity of the surrounding communities. Therefore, the committee may deny any entry not appropriately representing these qualities. For safety reasons, nothing may be thrown from a parade entry and no water guns are permitted. If you wish to have people walking along with your parade entry to toss items (e.g. candy) into the crowd, that would be acceptable. All entries must be decorated in accordance with the spirit of Memorial Day. All motorized vehicles, including ATV's, must be driven by a licensed driver. No double riders on horseback, no inexperienced riders, and no untrained or unmanageable horses are permitted. Registration deadline is May 20th.
